

5139 BMR Forage Sorghum

Forage sorghum is typically the tallest and most leafy type of summer forage. Forage sorghum is the most "corn like", meaning that it has wider leaves, and is not able to produce much regrowth after cutting. Forage sorghum is ideally suited for single cut operations, such as silage. Due to its large stalk it is not suited for hay.



This early maturity forage sorghum offers a quick silage harvest for producers looking for a fast maturing, high-tonnage single cut option. It is very digestible and palatable.

Seeding Method: Plant or Drill on 15" rows

Seeding Rate: 6-9# / acre

Seeding Depth: 1" - 1.5"

Seeding Dates: 5/10 - 6/15

Notes: Best for 20" or 30" rows, but can be drilled in 15" rows if no other option is available. Have nitrogen available to achieve optimal yield.
