

Birdsfoot Trefoil

Birdsfoot trefoil is a non-bloating perennial legume that is very winter-hardy. It can handle wetter soils than many alfalfa varieties.

It is a bit slower to establish than most perennial species, but it is likely to persist longer, if allowed to produce seed every few years prior to mowing.

It is a great option for pasture, and can be used for wet-wrapped hay.



Seeding Method: Frost-seed, Broadcast or Drill

Seeding Rate: 2-3# / acre in a mix or 6-8# / acre mono

Seeding Depth: 1/4" deep

Seeding Dates: 2/15 - 5/1 or 8/1-9/10

Notes: Best for pasture, not hay
