

## Alsike Clover

Alsike is a short lived perennial clover that is more tolerant of wet soils and soils with low pHs than most other clover species. It can be used for forage, wildlife and soil health.

Alsike clover is very winter hardy and persistent. It can withstand short periods of water-logged soils. For areas with higher fertility levels and adequate drainage, other clovers are typically utilized, as they are likely to provide higher yields.

Like other clovers, there is a bloat risk with alsike clover. For regrowth, do not harvest or allow animals to graze to heights below 2 inches.

<b>Seeding Method:</b>	Frost seed, drill, broadcast
<b>Seeding Rate:</b>	6-8# full stand, 1-3# for mixes & overseeding
<b>Seeding Depth:</b>	1/4"
<b>Seeding Dates:</b>	Seeding Dates: 2/15 - 5/1 or 8/15 - 9/20
<b>Notes:</b>	Can cause bloat, manage appropriately. May be slow to dry down for hay.
