

Sorghum-Sudangrass is a flexible option for those who are looking for both tonnage and quality. It can be hayed (best when planted at 35+#/acre), chopped, or grazed. Most producers use it as a multi-cut option.

Sorghum-sudangrass has a risk of prussic acid poisoning, manage accordingly. Multi-cut option, for best re-growth leave at least 6" of growth.

4105 is both BMR (brown midrib) and PPS (photo-period-sensitive) making it a premium quality summer annual that offers maximize tonnage and quality by reducing the chance of the plant producing a seed head. This helps it to produce high yielding, palatable forage throughout the whole growing season!



Seeding Method: Drill or Plant

Seeding Rate: 25-40#/acre. (Higher rate = finer stems)

Seeding Depth: 1/2" - 1"

Seeding Dates: 5/10 - 7/15

Notes: For best dry hay, make sure mower has a conditioner. Manage potential for nitrate or prussic acid poisoning.
