

Smooth Brome Grass

Smooth brome grass is a very persistent and productive cool season grass. Brome is known for its winter-hardiness and durability. It prefers well drained soils.

Smooth brome grass is a sod-forming grass, making it a very good option to help control erosion.

It tends to be a bit slow to establish, so consider adding a companion crop at the time of seeding to increase first year tonnage. Brome is best suited for a 2 cut system.



Seeding Method: Frost seed, Drill, or Broadcast

Seeding Rate: 15-18# mono, 4-6# in a mix

Seeding Depth: 1/4" - 1/2"

Seeding Dates: 3/10 - 5/1 or 8/15 - 9/20

Notes: Fairly fluffy seed, consider mixing with oats in grain box instead of small seed.
