

## Medium Red Clover

Medium red clover is a popular option for waterways, hay fields and pastures. This biennial legume offers great palatability and tonnage. It compliments grasses very well as it helps to fix nitrogen, which can enhance their performance!



Medium red clover typically lasts for two years. It is a great option to frost seed for thickening pastures and alfalfa fields! Leave at least 2" for best regrowth.

Available as raw seed or coated seed. Coated seed contains inoculant.

<b>Seeding Method:</b>	Frost seed, drill, broadcast
<b>Seeding Rate:</b>	15# full stand, 4-12# for mixes & overseeding
<b>Seeding Depth:</b>	1/4" - 1/2"
<b>Seeding Dates:</b>	Seeding Dates: 2/15 - 5/1 or 8/15 - 9/20
<b>Notes:</b>	Rates over 10# can be hard to dry down. Can cause bloat, manage appropriately. Use inoculant to maximize nitrogen fixation.
