

Bonus Teff Grass

Teff is a very fine summer annual grass that makes exceptional quality dry hay, and can command a premium! Teff grass does not have a risk of prussic acid poisoning.

Teff should be planted in late May - early July. First cut is typically 50 days after planting, with subsequent cuts every 30 days. To establish teff grass, seed into a firm seed bed. Place seed no deeper than 1/8".

Cut prior to seed heads emerging in order to maximize regrowth for subsequent cuts. Plan to allow cut teff to dry for several days prior to baling if making dry hay.

Bonus is an improved teff variety that offers high yields, and improved disease resistance.

Seeding Method: Drill very shallow, or Broadcast and Mulch

Seeding Rate: 7-9# / acre

Seeding Depth: 1/8" - NO DEEPER

Seeding Dates: 5/10 - 7/10

Notes: Do NOT seed too deep! Firm seedbed is necessary!
