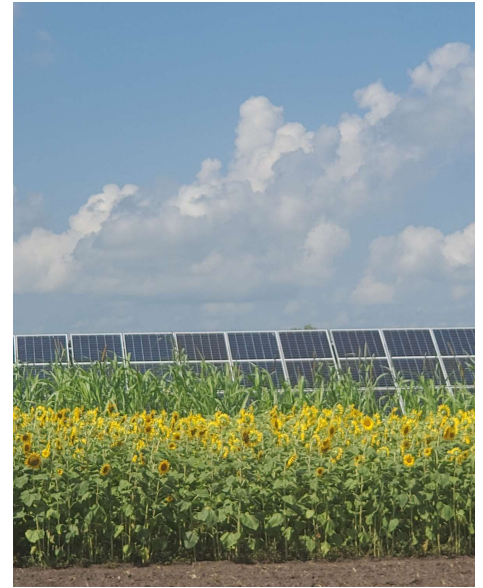
Peredovik Sunflowers

Peredovik Sunflowers are most commonly planted for a game bird plot, often for doves. Peredoviks will reach a height of approximately 4-5 feet in mature height.

What do they do: Sunflowers are very beneficial to soil health and attractive to pollinators in addition to attracting wildlife. Deer prefer immature sunflowers, and game birds prefer mature sunflowers. Peredoviks will reach full maturity in approximately 80-90 days from planting.

Site Prep & Planting: Sunflowers do best when they are planted 1" - 1.5" deep in 20" or 30" rows. Peredoviks do not offer any herbicide tolerance. Do not plant until soil temperatures have reached a daily minimum of 50° F.

Maintenance: Will winter kill.



Seeding Method: Plant

Seeding Rate: 15-25# / acre

Seeding Depth: 1" - 1.5"

Seeding Dates: 5/15 - 8/1

Notes: Available in 10# or 50# bags.
