Prairie Flower Medley

Wanting to add some native flowers for a pop of color and to attract pollinators? Or have an area that you no longer want to mow? Prairie Flower Medley is an attractive option to increase diversity in or near your yard!

What's In It: Prairie Flower Medley has over 20 blooming species including: coneflowers, indian blanket, poppies, black-eyed susans, asters and much more!

Site Prep & Planting: Prairie Flower Medley should be broadcast and incorporated or drilled into bare soil. Oats should be used as a companion crop to reduce competition from weeds.

Maintenance: This mix will take a couple of years to thicken up. Do NOT mow it! Mowing will permanently set back some species and introduce more weeds. If desired, this mix can be burnt every two or three years.



Seeding Method: Drill or Broadcast & Incorporate

Seeding Rate: 8-10# / acre

Seeding Depth: 1/4"

Seeding Dates: 2/15-5/1

Notes: Can be fall seeded, but spring is best.
Available by the pound and in small packs!
