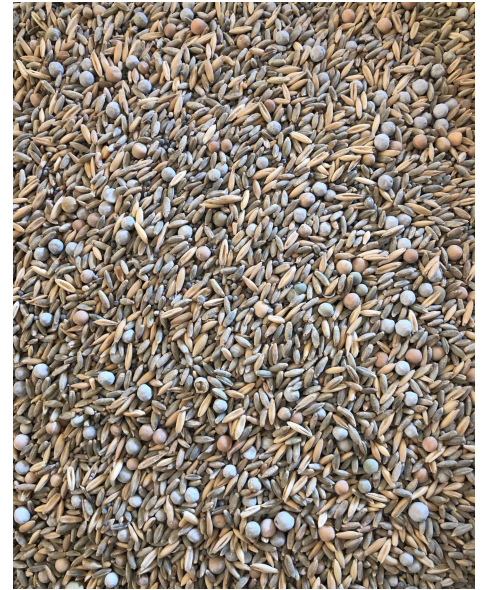
Buck'N Crazy®

Buck'N Crazy® is our most popular food plot for a simple reason - IT WORKS! This mixture is updated annually with varieties that have a proven track record of being easy to establish, supremely attractive, and very palatable.

What's In It: We know and understand that local populations have different preferences, that can sometimes change throughout the season. Buck'N Crazy® has enough variety in it to attract even the pickiest eaters! It contains multiple grains (oats, wheat, rye) along with at least three brassicas (radishes, rapes, turnips) and at least two legumes (clovers and peas).

Site Prep & Planting: This mix is meant to be seeded pretty shallow, so have a firm seed bed to start. Buck'N Crazy® should be seeded and lightly incorporated in late July or very early August for best brassica development. It can be seeded into September, but the brassica species will not be as large.

Maintenance: Buck'N Crazy® requires some supplemental fertilizer for maximum production. We suggest using a balanced fertilizer (such as 12-12-12) at a rate of 4 bags per acre. Most of the species in this mix will winter-kill (but they will still offer feed value all winter long); however, the cereal rye and clover will likely persist into the summer. Most folks tear the plot up and start fresh every year, but some will reseed brassicas the next fall to make it last two years!



Seeding Method: Drill or Broadcast & Incorporate

Seeding Rate: 50# / acre

Seeding Depth: 1/4" - 1/2"

Seeding Dates: 7/15 - 9/25
