

<u>RegalGraze White Clover</u>

RegalGraze is a very large leafed white clover that is bred to be very grazing tolerant. It is designed to be palatable and attractive to both livestock and wildlife. RegalGraze can persist for several years in the Midwest and can withstand grazing pressure.

RegalGraze clover can be a challenge to dry down, so it is not recommended for use in hay fields, but instead utilize it in pastures and wildlife areas.

Some species (horses especially) are not well-suited to white clover.

RegalGraze comes pre-coated and inoculated.

Seeding Method:	Frost seed, drill, broadcast
Seeding Rate:	6-8# full stand, 1-3# for mixes & overseeding
Seeding Depth:	1/4″
Seeding Dates:	Seeding Dates: 2/15 - 5/1 or 8/15 - 9/20
Notes:	White clover can be hard to dry down.
	Can cause bloat, manage appropriately.
	Use inoculant to maximize nitrogen fixation.
