

White Proso Millet

White Proso Millet is a summer annual that is typically used for wildlife plots but can be used as an emergency forage. It prefers well drained soils, and cannot handle wet feet.

Proso Millet is less palatable than the other millets for livestock; however, it can be used in emergency forage situations. It is the quickest growing millet option, and harvest can occur within 40 days of seeding. It is moderately drought tolerant. It does not like wet feet.

For wildlife plots, allow seed heads to mature and drop seeds. Seed head emergence is roughly 65 days after planting.

Seeding Method:	Drill or Incorporate
Seeding Rate:	20 - 25# / acre
Seeding Depth:	1/2" - 1" deep
Seeding Dates:	5/10 - 7/10
Notes:	Proso Millet has no prussic acid risk, but nitrates should still be managed appropriately.
