

## Vernal Alfalfa

Vernal alfalfa is an older variety that is renowned for its durability and persistence. It is typically used in mixtures, versus as a pure stand. It is often incorporated into waterways or areas of CSP (government cost share) as an economical way to add a legume.

Vernal is likely to persist longer than most other varieties; however, its yield is likely to be significantly less than what newer genetics can offer, making the newer varieties the more profitable option.
