


Alpine 2 Orchardgrass

Alpine II Orchardgrass is a top-rated, very late-maturing orchardgrass. It's able to produce high-quality, disease-free forage later in the season, making it the industry's go-to for very late orchardgrass, especially as a companion crop with alfalfa, red clover or other legumes.

Alpine II Orchardgrass exhibits superb agronomic traits such as strong seedling vigor, quick establishment, and high winterhardiness as well.



Seeding Method:	Frost seed, Drill, Broadcast
Seeding Rate:	10-15# mono, 4-8# for mixes & overseeding
Seeding Depth:	1/4" - 1/2"
Seeding Dates:	2/15 - 5/1 or 8/15 - 9/20
Notes:	For best regrowth and winter hardiness, leave 3-4" of stubble
