Buck Forage Oats

Oats are a quick growing grain. They have wide, lush leaves that are very palatable. Oats are very digestible and nutritious.

Site Prep & Planting: Oats can be spring planted to provide spring forage and to help suppress weeds throughout the summer if desired. Also, they can be planted in late July - early fall to offer a lush green option in the fall months. Oats can be drilled or broadcasted by themselves or with other species.

Maintenance: Will winter kill once the temperatures fall into the low twenties. Fertilize with a high nitrogen fertilizer to promote growth.



Seeding Method: Drill or Broadcast

Seeding Rate: 25-50#/acre in mix, 100#/acre mono

Seeding Depth: 1" - 1.5"

Seeding Dates: 7/15 - 9/1

Notes: Available in 50# bags
