

Forage Kentucky Bluegrass

Forage Kentucky Bluegrass can be a great option for areas where erosion control and weed suppression are desired. KBG is very palatable and does well in times of cool weather with adequate moisture.

Kentucky Bluegrass goes dormant earlier in summer than many other more heat tolerant species, so it is often used in mixtures.

KBG has a very dense, fibrous root system that offers great erosion control, sod formation and weed suppression. It is important to know that you are getting a forage-type instead of a turf-type to increase the tonnage produced.

Seeding Method: Frost seed, Drill, or Broadcast

Seeding Rate: 12-15# mono, 2-4# for mixes

Seeding Depth: 1/4"

Seeding Dates: 2/15 - 5/1 or 8/15 - 9/20

Notes: Make sure to get a FORAGE VARIETY!
