

Pearl Millet

Pearl Millet is a great option for those that do not want to have to manage a sorghum product. It has no prussic acid risk. It can be grazed, hayed, or chopped. Pearl Millet is a high-tonnage option for quality forage - without risk of prussic acid!



Pearl Millet is a multi-cut product, but make sure to leave at least 5" to allow for re-growth. BMR (brown midrib) varieties may be available to enhance available nutrition.

Pearl Millet can be dry-hayed, but planting rates should be raised to reduce stalk size.

Seeding Method: Drill or Incorporate

Seeding Rate: 20 - 40# / acre

Seeding Depth: 1/2" - 1" deep

Seeding Dates: 5/10 - 7/10

Notes: Pearl Millet has no prussic acid risk, but nitrates should still be managed appropriately.
