

Sorghum-Sudangrass

Sorghum-Sudangrass is a flexible option for those who are looking for both tonnage and quality. It can be hayed (best when planted at 35+#/acre), chopped, or grazed. Most producers use it as a multi-cut option. Sorghum-sudangrass has a risk of prussic acid poisoning, manage accordingly. Multi-cut option, for best regrowth leave at least 6" of growth.



4555 Sorghum-sudangrass is a BMR (brown midrib) variety that offers enhanced palatability and digestibility all season!

Seeding Method: Drill or Plant

Seeding Rate: 25-40#/acre. (Higher rate = finer stems)

Seeding Depth: 1/2" - 1"

Seeding Dates: 5/10 - 7/15

Notes: For best dry hay, make sure mower has a conditioner. Manage potential for nitrate or prussic acid poisoning.
