

## Reed Canarygrass

Reed Canarygrass is known for its ability to tolerate wet soils. It is a very aggressive, sod-forming grass that thrives in wet areas such as alongside creeks or ditches.

Reed canarygrass is quite slow to establish; however, once well established, it can become quite aggressive. It has excellent winter hardiness and persistence. It can start to spread into stands of cool season species if not well managed.

For best results, cut or graze reed canarygrass at least four times per season. Do not clip below 4" height. If it begins spreading beyond desired area, mow at low heights to control.

**Seeding Method:** Drill or Broadcast

**Seeding Rate:** 8-10 PLS pounds\*

**Seeding Depth:** 1/4" - 1/2"

**Seeding Dates:** 3/1 - 5/1 or 8/15 - 9/20

**Notes:** Consider new varieties with enhanced palatability that are low alkaloid. \*Reed canarygrass seed germ can vary. Check tags!
