<u> Annual Ryegrass - Forage</u>

While annual ryegrass is most commonly used as a cover crop, it can be used as a short term forage option as well.

Annual ryegrass can be seeded as a companion crop with other cool season forage species. It can also be seeded at higher rates by itself or with other species to be a quick-grow emergency forage.

When choosing an annual ryegrass for forage, look for a tetraploid variety that will offer improved palatability.

Seeding Method:	Frost seed, Drill, or Broadcast
Seeding Rate:	25-30# mono, 4-9# for mixes & overseeding
Seeding Depth:	1/4" - 1/2"
Seeding Dates:	2/15 - 5/1 or 8/15 - 9/20
Notes:	Ryegrass can be challenging to dry down
	for dry hay. When using for hay, keep
	ryegrass at less than 20% of the mix.
