

Devour Orchardgrass

Devour is a late maturing orchardgrass that was bred to be very grazing tolerant. Devour is a high yielding orchardgrass that has exceptional palatability. It has lush leaves and is very persistent.

Devour tends to be more “floppy” and less erect than traditional orchardgrass varieties. This makes it ideal for pastures and grazing systems; however, it is not the best choice to pair with alfalfa due to its growth habit.



Seeding Method:	Frost seed, Drill, Broadcast
Seeding Rate:	10-15# mono, 4-8# for mixes & overseeding
Seeding Depth:	1/4" - 1/2"
Seeding Dates:	2/15 - 5/1 or 8/15 - 9/20
Notes:	For best regrowth and winter hardiness, leave 3-4" of stubble
