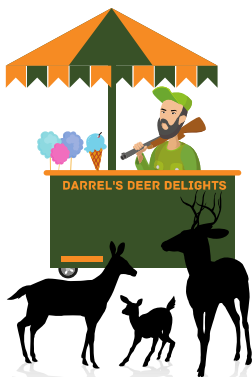
Sweet Treat

Sweet Treat is a multi species brassica mixture that contains a bit of white clover. This mixture is designed to reach it's peak in early October, but then it gets even sweeter after a killing frost. The frost will cause the sugars in the brassicas to concentrate in the roots, and deer will dig them up all winter (or until they are gone!).

What's In It: This mix has sugar beets, multiple types of turnips, rape seed, and a hybrid brassica. We also have sprinkled in a bit of white clover, to help offer some attraction in early spring and reduce weeds.

Site Prep & Planting: For best results, Sweet Treat needs to be seeded about 1/4" deep into the soil. So drilling or broadcast and incorporating are preferred. Some success can be had by just seeding on top of soil, but brassica bulbs are likely to be smaller.

Maintenance: Sweet Treat should have a balanced fertilizer (such as 12-12-12) applied at planting. With the exception of the white clover, this mixture will winterkill. The clover can last for several years, but will need thickened up with either additional clover or brassicas. Or you can terminate the clover and start fresh the following fall!



Seeding Method: Drill or Broadcast & Incorporate

Seeding Rate: 8-10# / acre

Seeding Depth: 1/4"

Seeding Dates: 7/15 - 8/25

Notes: Available in 5# or 25# bags!
