Yellow Blossom Sweet Clover is a biennial clover that is often used for forage or as green manure. It has the capability to produce significant biomass and fix high levels of nitrogen, up to 150# per acre is possible under the right conditions.

Yellow Blossom Sweet Clover is also a very popular option for pollinators and those with apiaries. YBSC is a primary component in our “MGF Pollinator’s Special” for those looking for a simple but attractive blooming mixture!



Seeding Method:	Frost seed, drill, broadcast
Seeding Rate:	10-15# mono, 1-3# for mixes & overseeding
Seeding Depth:	1/4" - 1/2"
Seeding Dates:	Seeding Dates: 2/15 - 5/1 or 8/15 - 9/20
Notes:	Prolific seed producer, so manage seed heads accordingly.
